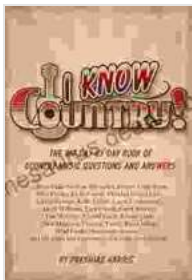

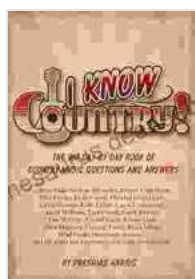
The artist with the most CMA Awards is Vince Gill, with 21 wins.

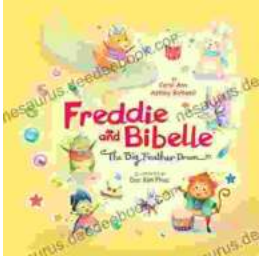
